

<u>NEXT EVENT</u>

<u>SUNDAY – AUGUST 18th – Flag</u> Tournament (Make-Up Date)

- Non-flighted Net event, every man/woman for themselves.
- Every player will be given a flag and an assigned number of strokes based on their handicap to get as far as they can on the course.
- For example, if you are a 10 handicap, your handicap will be added to even par, which is 72, so you will have 82 stokes to get as far as you can on the course.
 Once your 82nd stroke has come to rest you will place your flag in the ground. Places will be determined by who gets farthest on the course.
- If you reach your last stroke before you finish your 18th hole you will place your flag in the ground wherever your last strokes comes to rest. If you have strokes remaining after you finish 18 holes, you will go back to hole

1 and continue to play golf until you hit your final stroke.

- You are required to play every hole as it is intended and for players that finish close to or on the green, places will be determined by whoever is closest to the hole.
- If you place your flag in the ground before you finish 18 holes, still finish your round because we will be playing a skins game like we normally do.
- \$10 per player for skins and
 50/50 (\$5 to skins, \$5 to 50/50)
- I will have another sign-up sheet in the Pro Shop in the near future and will be sending an email to remind all members of the makeup date.

<u>August 31st – 2-Person</u> <u>Cumulative</u>

 I will send an email with the details of this event following the flag tournament.

<u>Remaining Schedule</u>

AUGUST 18TH – FLAG TOURNAMENT AUGUST 31ST – 2-PERSON CUMULATIVE SEPTEMBER 21ST – 2-PERSON TEXAS SCRAMBLE OCTOBER 5TH – 2-PERSON MODIFIED SCRAMBLE OCTOBER 12TH – KING OF THE HILL (if qualified)

If you are interested in joining the BTGA you still can. You must be a Bear Trail member to participate. There are 4 events remaining and then the year end King of the Hill that you would need to qualify for based on earned points throughout the season. With 4 events left there are still plenty of opportunities to earn points to qualify for the year end King of the Hill. Even if you do not qualify for the King of the Hill there are still 4 more opportunities to play in events and win some cash. We have had 4 Tournaments for the BTGA since March and have handed out over **\$3,300** in cash prizes for in flight prize money for places, skins and 50/50.

THURSDAY BLITZ POINTS LEAGUE

If you are not already aware, Bear Trail Golf Club has a Thursday League called the Blitz Points League. This is a 9-hole Blitz Points/Stableford style league that alternates between front 9 and back 9 each week. You get an assigned quota of points that you are trying to get to each week. Your quota is initially based on your handicap but then is adjusted every week based on how you play in the league. Your goal each week is to get as many points as possible.

- Max Double Bogey (pick up if at double to speed up play)
- Bogey 1 point
- Par 2 points
- Birdie 4 points
- Eagle 8 Points
- Albatross 16 Points

Every week we pay out 1st, 2nd and 3rd places to the individuals that get the most points over their established quotas and those that win skins. Since the first week of the league this year, that started on March 14th, we have handed out **\$3,500** in 21 weeks. There are typically anywhere from 15 to 25 people that play on a given week so pots can fluctuate depending on the amount of people that play but the format is fair to people of all skill levels.

To join the league there are \$25 nonrefundable dues that are used to purchase the money leader trophy, pay out the sandbagger of the year and pay for food for the year end tournament. Then it is \$10 cash each week to get into the game. Your \$10 per week DOES NOT go towards your greens fees (nonmembers) or cart fees (members).

You can play anytime on Thursday as long as you check-in in the Pro Shop prior to 6:00pm when they close. You do not have to be a member of Bear Trail Golf Club to participate in the Thursday League. However, you do need to play with another member of the league in order for your score to count each week. Cash payouts will be placed in envelopes and in the Pro Shop to pick up typically the weekend following Thursday play but no later than the next week of play.
