

## **SUPER BEAR SKINS ON SUPER BOWL SATURDAY**

### **VOLUME 5**

Format:

Where does that \$100 go?

Flight Skins \$25: Flights will be determined by the number of players and handicaps. Only players in a flight can win a skin. Example: player in flight A can only win a skin against others in A flight. Flight A players cannot win a skin against flight B.

Super Skins \$25: A Super Skin is when a player has a skin that isn't cut by any other player in the field no matter what flight they are in.

Modified Stableford Blind Draw Team \$10: Players will earn points based off of their score on each hole. Teams will be drawn at the conclusion of play. 3 or 4 man teams, low net combined score wins. All ties will be split evenly.

Modified Stableford Individual \$15: Top 30% of field paid, ties broken per USGA rules.

Polies \$10: If the tee shot on a par 3 is within a flag stick length of the hole the player has a "polie".

Food \$15

Day of play rules will be decided on the day of the event based of weather and course conditions. Member cart fee not included. Guest fee is \$47.42. Range balls included for all.

#### **Payment Options:**

##### **Option 1 – Pay As You Go**

- \$40 Non-Refundable Dues to get into the BTGA
- \$25 entry fee to get into each event (8 events)
- If a member chooses this option and plays in every event, it will be a total of \$240 for the entire season.

##### **Option 2 – 50% off to Pay Up Front**

- \$120 Non-Refundable upfront prior to the first event
- Gets you into all 8 events for the year.
- No additional dues or entry fees

Additionally, every event will have a skins game and 50/50 which is \$10 a person at each event (\$5 toward skins, \$5 toward 50/50). Cart fees still apply for your round as well.

In the 8 events last year and the year-end King of the Hill, we gave out just over \$6,400 in cash prizes throughout the year. The money that you pay to get into the BTGA is used for payouts throughout the year and ultimately goes right back into BTGA members' pockets. Every event is

flighted, so I try to do my best to pay out as many places as possible in each flight for every event.

There are currently sign-up sheets in the Pro Shop as well that you will need to fill out, so we know what payment option you are choosing. You can pay cash when you turn in your signup sheet or pay at the first event on March 8<sup>th</sup>.

## **THURSDAY BLITZ POINTS LEAGUE**

### **STARTS MARCH 13<sup>TH</sup>, 2025**

Over the last 2 years we have been doing a Thursday League at Bear Trail and in those 2 years we have given out over \$10,000 in cash prizes to members of this league. The league will restart on **March 13<sup>th</sup>** when the clocks spring back forward.

This is a 9-hole individual league in which you are initially assigned a certain number of points that you have to get each week based on your handicap. Then after the first 3 weeks your assigned points will be adjusted based on how you play each week in the league. You can play anytime on Thursdays between the time the pro shop opens to the time the pro shop closes at 6:00 pm, as long as you play with at least one other member of the league. There will be a list of league members in the pro shop each week that has everyone's assigned points

and you will need to check in and pay your \$10 before you play your 9-hole round.

To get into the league there is an initial one-time dues payment required of \$25. Once you have paid your dues, it is \$10 each week to get into the game which goes towards payouts for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> places for the individuals that score the most points over their assigned points and towards skins. Cart fees and greens fees still apply. You do not have to be a member of Bear Trail to play in this league. Payouts will be given to winners every week, typically by the weekend following the Thursday of league play. \$25 dues payments will be used to purchase the championship belt that goes to the yearlong money leader, the sandbagger of the year award, awarded to the individual that got the most total points over their quota, throughout the year, and for food at the yearend event.

Scoring for the league is as follows:

- Double Bogey – 0 Points
- Bogey – 1 Point
- Par – 2 Points
- Birdie – 4 Points
- Eagle – 8 Points.

There are currently sign-up sheets in the Pro Shop that you will need to fill out before you play so I can determine what everyone's initial points will be based on their handicaps. ## 2025 INTERCLUB

Kyle recently sent out an email to all members pertaining to the 2025 Interclub Season. Interclub is when members of Bear Trail Golf Club go and play other teams of members of other courses in the area. Below are the basics of interclub:

**FORMAT:** Interclub team competition involves 8 players from each club competing in a net four-ball match play format. CGA interclub offers three age divisions:

- **CAROLINAS:** Interclub division for players **18 years of age and older**. Matches primarily played on weekends but may be played on weekdays
- **SENIOR:** Interclub division for players **55 years of age and older**. Matches primarily played on weekdays but may be played on weekends.
- **SUPER-SENIOR:** Interclub division for players **65 years of age and older**. Matches primarily played on weekdays but may be played on weekends.

**\*\*As long as your age allows you to play, players may also play in more than 1 age division. Example: If you are at age 55 you can play in the Carolinas Division as well as the Senior Division etc.\*\***



If you use the USGA GHIN (Golf Handicap and Information Network) system to track your handicap this is a friendly reminder that the \$30 dues are due by March 31<sup>st</sup>. If you are wanting to register for the GHIN to start a handicap through Bear Trail, please contact Kyle Simpson through the Pro Shop and he will assist in getting you registered. ***Everyone that is participating in the BTGA should be registering for a GHIN handicap.***

- \$20 per Team (\$10 per man)
- \$10 goes towards skins and \$10 goes to 50/50

Ages 59 and under play from the White Tees  
Ages 60 and above play from the Gold Tees  
Ages 70 and above play from the Green Tees  
Ages 50 and under (4 Handicap or Better) play from the Black Tees  
Ladies play the Red Tees  
Ladies ages 60 and above play the Light Blue Tees
